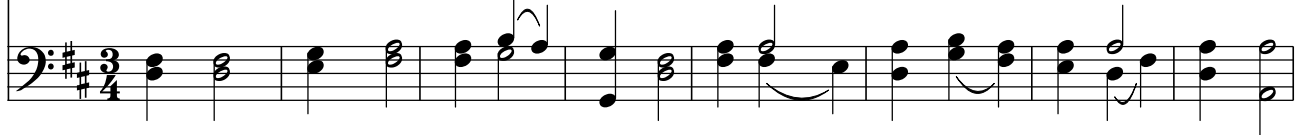

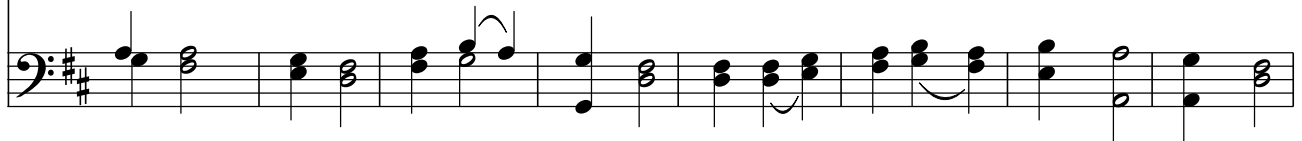
A psalm of David
