



# Psalm 51:13-19

13. I'll teach trans-gres-sors then your ways, and sin-ners shall re-turn to you.  
Then shall my tongue sing with great joy be-cause of your right-eous-ness.  
16. For you de-sire not sac-ri-fice. Else I would give it un-to you.
