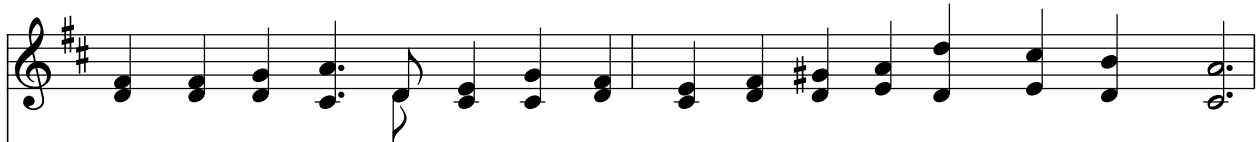


Psalm 71:1-13
