


Psalm 85

To the chief musician, a psalm of the sons of Korah




1.LORD, you have fa - vor shown your land. You have turned Ja - cob's cap - tives back.

9.His help is near those who fear him, that glo - ry in our land may dwell.




2.In - deed, you have borne for them the in - i - qui - ty of your peo - ple.
